5. Committee Reports:

### RLF/UDAG – April 24, 2018:

- Recommend to Council to rewrite the loan for Precision Ice Blast at a five-year term with a 3% fixed interest rate with the City of Peshtigo subordinating its loan to the USDA loan at Byline Bank provided the outstanding February, March and April 2018 loan payments are paid by April 30, 2018. The payment schedule thereafter being set at \$5,000 monthly payments for each of May 2018 and June 2018 and then 57 monthly payments of \$2,071.74 with a balloon payment for the balance due at the end of the loan term. If the May or June 2018 payments are not made within 30 days of the due dates the interest rate would increase to 4% for the life of the loan.
