

BADGER PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL -

1. The Parks & Recreation Director, Night Watchman, Police Officers and any Parks Employee may eject any patron from the park area for any disorderly behavior.
2. Any Badger Park patron that is in violation of a law, will be turned over to the Peshtigo Police Department.
3. Please deposit all debris in the receptacles provided. Help keep the park clean for everyone to enjoy.
4. City Ordinance requires that: PETS OF ALL SPECIES must be on a leash at all times. Animal droppings must be picked up immediately.

CAMPGROUND -

1. Must be 18 or older to register.
2. Individuals 17 and under may be at the campgrounds over night ONLY when accompanied by an adult who is registered at the park office.
3. Quiet hours are designated to be between 12:00 PM and 6:00 AM within the confines of the park area. Only designated campers are allowed to stay within the campground after 11 PM.
4. Do not over load outlets and NO electric heaters allowed in campers or tents.
 - 4a. Max: 2 tents per site; 1 camper per site.
5. One picnic table and burning receptacle per site.
 - 5a. Screen tent for eating; no charge.
6. Please keep fires small and return all unused wood to the pile. Wood is free at the present time - when available.
7. ALL VISITORS AND GUESTS of campers are asked to park in the parking lot across from the park office. No more than TWO VEHICLES allowed per campsite at any time.
8. CAMPERS MAY NOT OFFER ITEMS FOR SALE FROM THEIR TENTS, TRAILERS, OR CAMPSITES DURING THEIR STAY AT BADGER PARK CAMPGROUNDS.
9. A 1st night \$2.00 dumping fee will be collected from all campers with self contained restrooms on the first day of the reservation.

RESERVATIONS - Reservations for campsites may be made:

Before the season: 715-582-3041 City Hall (9am-12 & 1-5PM - Monday thru Friday)

During the season: 715-582-4321 Park Office (7PM - 11PM Wednesday thru Sunday)

1. Reservations will be limited to only two weeks in duration for any specific campsite.
2. All reservations for multiple (three or more) campground sites, must be paid in full in advance; and payment made within two weeks of the verbal commitment.
