Swimming Lessons

We are once again offering Indoor Swimming Lessons for a 2-week, 8-lesson session. The \$36 fee covers all 8 lessons and includes transportation to and from the **River Cities Community Pool** (Max E Peterson Fieldhouse). The eight dates of the program are Monday through Thursday, June 16 to 19, and June 23 to 26.



Departure and return drop off will take place in front of the Peshtigo Elementary Learning Center for each session. The lessons are one-hour in length (1 to 2 PM), so pick up will be at 12:30 p.m. and return at about 2:30 p.m. The dates and times run concurrently with the Summer School program run by the Peshtigo School District. Parks personnel will chaperone the children at all times.

Space is limited to the first 50 children who register.

Soccer



Summer Soccer is being offered in two age groups. Group A (for K to 3rd Grade) will play on Mondays at 1 PM on the following dates: June 23, 30, July 7, 14, 21, and 28. Group B (for 4 to 6th Grade) will play on Wednesday at 1 PM on the following dates: June 25, July 2, 9, 16, 23 and 30.

The location of the practices/games will be the practice field behind Field #1 (the north field) at the Eastside Ball Field Complex. The cost for Soccer is \$5 for city residents, \$10 for non-residents.

Fishing 101

Fishing 101 is a 5 week course taught by a Certified Fishing Instructor. The courses will cover the basics of fishing, like fish identification, knot tying, lures and baits, fish habitats, unhooking a fish, fishing rules, etc. The classes will be on Fridays at 1 PM and will be held at the Small Pavilion at Badger Park. The dates are Fridays June 20, 27, July 11, 18, and 25

The class size will be limited to the first 15 who sign up and is open to children from age 5 to 12. Children are encouraged to bring their own poles, but if they have none, poles will be provided.

The cost of Fishing 101 is \$5 for city residents, \$10 for non-residents.



Unstructured Play

Unstructured Play is just what the name describes—the type of activity or game will change from week to week. Some games will be planned by the staff, at other times the children will choose or invent their own game.

Unstructured Play will be held at Badger Park by Badger Boardwalk. The classes will be held on Friday mornings, from 9 to 10:30 AM. The dates are June 20, 27, July 11, 18, 25, August 1 & 8.

We will divide the class into two age groups: K to 2nd Grade, and 3rd to 6th Grade, with each group playing in different areas of the Park.

Cost for Unstructured Play is \$1 per class, payable up front or on the day of.

Arts & Crafts

This class will be offered Monday thru Thursday, at 10 AM in the Large Pavilion. Classes will be broken down in the following fashion:



4 & 5 year old: July 7, 8, 9, & 10—Cost will be \$3 for residents, \$6 for non-residents.

6 & 7 year olds: July 14, 15, 16 & 17--Cost will be \$4 for residents, \$8 for non-residents.

8 & 9 year olds: July 21, 22, 23 & 24--Cost will be \$6 for residents, \$12 for non-residents.

10 to 12 year olds: July 28, 29, 30, 31--Cost will be \$6 for residents, \$12 for non-residents.

3/4 Year Old T-Ball

This year we will be running a 4 week (2 per week) T-Ball programs for children ages 3 and 4.

The 3 year olds will play on the following Mondays and Wednesdays: July 14, 16, 21, 23, 28, 30, August 4 & 6.

The 4 year olds will play on the following Tuesdays and Thursday: July 15, 17, 22, 24, 29, 31, August 5 & 7.

The location of the practices will be at Field #1 (north field) at the Eastside Ball Fields. Practices/games will start at 6:00 PM and run for about an hour. Costs are \$5 for city residents, \$10 for non-city residents.



Aquatic Bugs and Insects



Anne Bartels, Education Specialist in the Marinette County Land and Water Conservation Division will be teaching her popular course on Aquatic Bugs, Trees and Insects on Monday thru Thursday, July 14 to 17. This class is open to all age groups and will include mini-trips to the river or the hiking trails to look for bugs and insects. The classes are from 9 to 10 AM, and will be held in the Large Pavilion. The cost of the program is \$2.00.


Sunday Night Beach Volleyball
