

ORDINANCE NO. 2016- 11
Amendment to Section 44-215 of City Ordinances

That Sec. 44-215 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Peshtigo, Wisconsin is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Sec. 44-215. Parking.

- (a) *Street Parking.* Except to temporarily park for not more than two hours, no person owning or having control of any truck, trailer, truck power unit, tractor, bus or recreation vehicle with a tare or empty weight in excess of 12,000 pounds gross weight, or over 16 feet in length (including accessories, racks, or other physical extensions), or having a height of more than eight feet from the roadway, shall park the same upon any street, avenue, or public way in the City between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. The provisions of this subsection shall not be deemed to prohibit the lawful parking of such equipment upon any street, avenue or public way in the City for the actual loading or unloading of goods, ware or merchandise; providing, however, the loading and unloading, as used in this section, shall be limited to the actual time consumed in such operation. The Common Council may, however, designate specific truck parking zones.
- (b) *Removal.* Any vehicle unlawfully parked under Subsection (a) of this section may be removed from the street by order of a law enforcement officer, pursuant to Section 44-441, and the expense of so moving and storing such vehicle shall be paid by the operator or owner of said vehicle as a forfeiture in addition to the penalties hereafter prescribed.
- (c) It shall be unlawful to park or leave standing upon a City street or alley any propelled or non-propelled vehicles including motor homes, commercial trucks, camper, snowmobile trailer, boat trailer, small mobile trailer, and semitrailer for a continuous period of seventy-two (72) hours. As used herein, "continuous" means for essentially the entire seventy-two (72) hour period and brief movement of transfer to an adjacent location shall not interrupt the seventy-two (72) hour period.
