

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01
AMENDING VARIOUS ORDINANCES REGARDING
LICENSE AND PERMIT FEES

The Common Council of the City of Peshtigo, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The following Sections of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Peshtigo are amended to read as hereafter provided:

(1) SEC. 10-140 is amended to read:

(a) **Fees for Building Permits and Inspections.** At the time the application for a building permit is filed, the applicant shall pay the following fees:

Zoning & Occupancy	\$50.00
New one and two-family dwellings (Includes water and sewer)	\$650.00
New commercial buildings and three or more family apartments (Includes water and sewer)	\$850.00
New industrial buildings (Includes water and sewer)	\$850.00
Residential remodeling and additions	\$75.00
Commercial remodeling and additions	\$250.00
Industrial remodeling and additions	\$250.00
Private garages and sheds	\$75.00
Signs	\$75.00
Sewer Permit	\$75.00
Water Permit	\$75.00
Razing Permit	\$75.00
Moving-out-of-town Permit	\$75.00
Moving and relocating within the city (Includes water and sewer)	\$75.00
Flammable liquid storage	\$75.00
Outdoor Wood Burning Heating Units	\$100.00

(2) SEC. 52-831 (i) is created to read:

(i) **Fee for Fence Permit.** At the time the application for a fence permit is filed, the applicant shall pay a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

(3) SEC. 52-832 (c) is created to read:

(b) **Permit Required.** Before work is commenced on the construction of recreation of private or residential swimming pools or on any alterations, additions, remodeling or other improvements, an application for a swimming pool building permit to construct, erect, alter, remodel or add must be submitted in writing to the Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator. Plans and specifications and pertinent explanatory data should be submitted to the Building Inspector/Zoning Administrator at the time of application. No work or any part of the work shall be commenced until a written permit for such work is obtained by the applicant. A fee of \$50.00 shall accompany such application.

(4) SEC. 52-893 (4) is created to read:

a. **Fee for Solar Access Permit.** At the time of issuance of a solar access permit, the applicant shall pay a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
