

Sec. 44-285. - Winter all-night parking.

- (a) *All-night parking prohibited.* Unless a permit therefor has been issued by the City Police Department, it shall be unlawful to park or leave unattended any automobile, truck or other motor vehicle between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m., inclusive, between December 1 and the March 31, both dates inclusive, on any of the following streets in the City:
 - (1) U.S. Highway 41;
 - (2) West Front Street;
 - (3) East Front Street;
 - (4) Oconto Avenue;
 - (5) Lake Street from French Street to the North City Limits;
 - (6) North Emery Avenue;
 - (7) East Park Drive;
 - (8) Aubin Street from East Park Drive to Harper Avenue;
 - (9) Harper Avenue.
- (b) *Parking prohibited during snow plowing.* Unless a permit therefor has been issued by the City Police Department, it is unlawful to park or leave unattended any automobile or other motor vehicle on any street or alley in the City during any period of time in which snow plowing or snow removal is taking place on such street or alley.
- (c) *Declared obstruction to public street.* Any motor vehicle stopped, parked, abandoned or otherwise left unattended in violation of this section is declared to be an obstruction to a public street and in violation of this section:
- (d) *Removal of vehicle in violation of these provisions.* In the event any motor vehicle is stopped, parked, abandoned or left unattended in violation of this section, or in violation of the terms of any permit issued by the City Police Department, the Chief of Police and individual members of the Police Department are authorized to remove or cause to be removed any such vehicle and to have such vehicles towed away and the expenses incurred for the towing away or storage of such vehicle shall be paid by the owner thereof.
