

Area Attractions!



Fishing/Boating

In a boat or on the shoreline, Peshtigo river is always fun to fish! Peshtigo also has two boat landings in the city; one above the dam and one below. Launch fees are \$3 per day.

Canoe/Kayak

The flowage above the dam is an easy trip on slow moving currents. Below the dam allows access to a scenic 11 mile trip down to the mouth of the river at the bay of Green Bay. There is also a Kayak launch for campers to access!

Hiking

Badger Park offers a 1.4 mile trail in the woods of Badger Park. The 1.2 mile trail in Peshtigo River Recreational Park also offers very scenic routes.

Disc Golf

A 9-hole course (soon to be 18) is contained within Badger Park. Rental discs.

Museum

The historic Peshtigo Fire Museum is a short 5 minute walk from the campground and worth the visit!

Groceries/Shopping/Restaurants/ATMs

Several unique spots within a one-mile walk of the Park. We have a grocery store located right on our main drag. Also other shopping within a 10 mile ride of Badger Park.

Bike Routes

The streets and roads around Peshtigo are excellent for short or long bike trips. Loner bikes are available at the campground!

Fish Viewing Platform

Take a walk or bike across the bridge and check out the information and fish from our new Fish Viewing Platform!



Directions to Peshtigo

From Michigan


Exit US 41 at Exit 216. Turn right onto Business 41. Follow to the city's only traffic signal (at N. Emery Ave.). Turn right. Travel north 0.3 miles to park entrance.

From the South:

Exit US 41 at Exit 212. Turn left onto Business 41. Follow for 0.8 miles to the city's only traffic signal (at N. Emery Ave.). Turn left. Travel north 0.3 miles to park entrance.

From the West (via HWY 64):

After crossing US 141, travel east 8.0 miles. Turn right onto County Highway D. Travel 6.3 miles into City of Peshtigo. Turn left at Oconto Avenue (stop sign). Travel 0.5 miles to traffic signal. Turn sharply left onto North Emery Avenue. Travel north 0.3 miles to park entrance.

About Badger Campground

Badger Park occupies 60 acres in the northern portion of the City. Our wooded Campground offers 42 camp sites including RV, tent, group, and Cabins.

Within the park is the Peshtigo River with 3000 feet of water frontage for the enjoyment of our visitors on hot summer days!

Regular campsites at Badger Park Campground have water and electric hook-up (most up to 50 amp.) Our rustic cabins also have electrical outlets and hold two sets of bunkbeds (furnish your own bedding). The 4 Walk-n-Tent sites are woody and have no water or electric but as all other sites, have their own private picnic table and fire ring.

Badger Campground is very fortunate to have our very own camphosts onsite 24/7! Mike, Wendy and Bean are always working to keep our campground beautiful, but also always available and willing to help in anyway possible!




Badger Park Campground Peshtigo, WI
